This is in reference to your application submitted to SEIAA, Odisha vide proposal number SIA/OR/MIN/484255/2024 dated 27/06/2024 for grant of an amendment in prior Environmental Clearance (EC) to the project for extraction of sand from Telijore Sand Bed over an area of 8.30 Acres or 3.358 ha at village-Telijore, Tahasil- Balisankara, District-Sundargarh, Odisha under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

1. In view of the particulars given in the Para-1 above, the project proposal interalia including Form-4 (Part A, B & C)

were submitted to the SEAC for an appraisal by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) under the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments thereto.

2. The above-mentioned proposal has been considered by SEAC in its meeting held on 31.08.2024. The minutes of the meeting and all the project documents are available on Parivesh portal which can be accessed from the Parivesh portal by scanning the QR Code above or through the following web link [click here](#).
3. The brief about the reasons for an amendment requested along with the brief on the salient features of the project as submitted by the project proponent in Form- 4 (Part A, B & C) and as presented before SEAC and the details of the amendment of EC are annexed as **Annexure- 2**.
4. The proposal was placed in the SEAC meeting held on 31.08.2024 under the provisions of EIA Notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments and after detailed deliberations in the matter and the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal as per the Replenishment Study Report with 8719 cum of sand subject to revision of mining plan where the maximum annual capacity is stated as 5000 cum.
5. The SEIAA, Odisha has examined the proposal in 176<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 25.10.2024 in accordance with the extant provisions of the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 & further amendments thereto and based on the recommendations of the SEAC and hereby accords amendment in Environment Clearance issued vide EC letter no. / EC Identification No. – 1177/SEIAA dated 30.03.2021 for the instant proposal Telijore Sand Bed to Sri Ajay Kumar Patel is **allowed** for extraction quantity of sand **7800 cum per annum** for the balance lease period under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof subject to compliance of EC conditions, general instructions issued vide EC letter dated 30/03/2021 and following additional specific conditions as mentioned in **Annexure-1**. The other stipulated terms and conditions of the original EC letter initially granted remains same.
6. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.

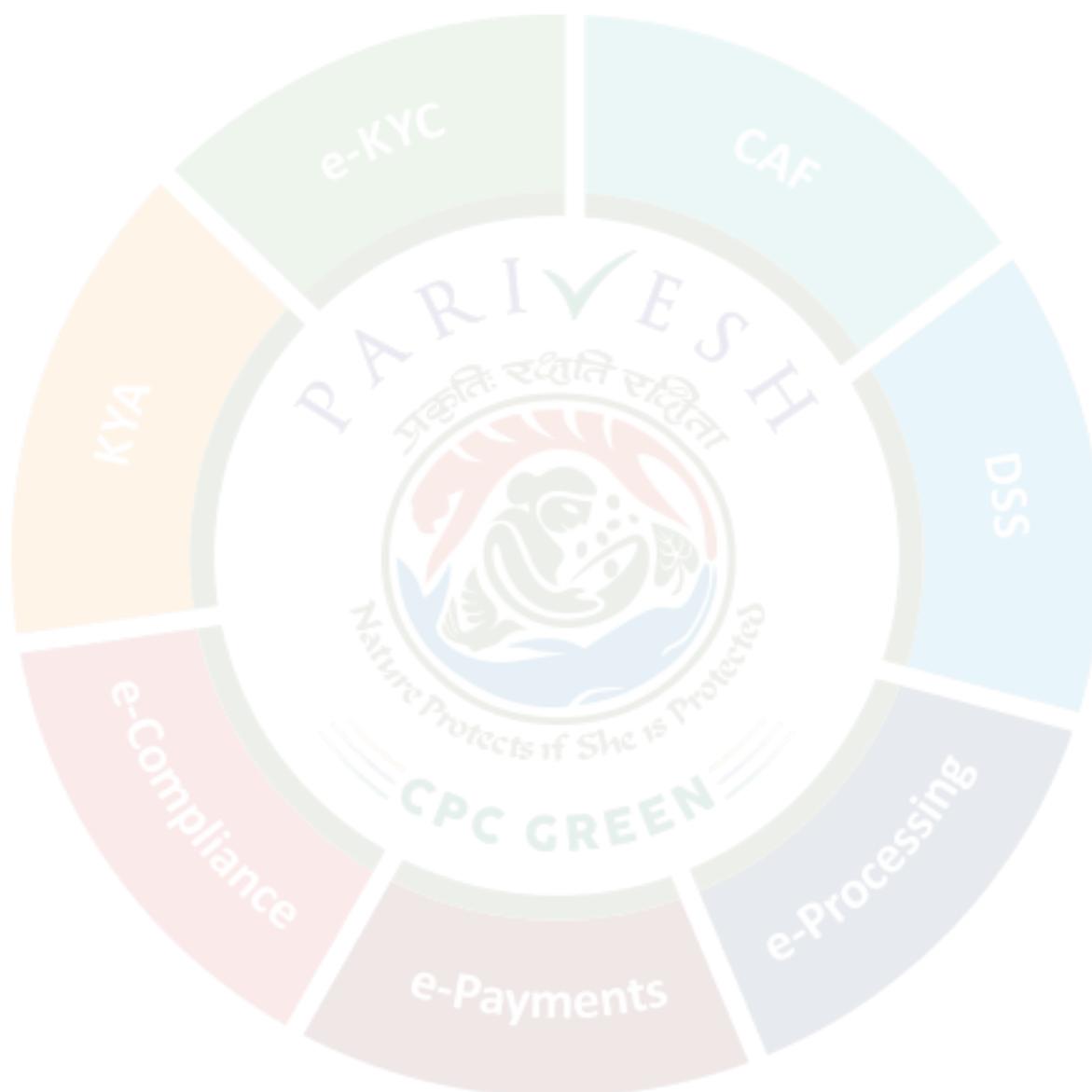

#### **Additional EC Conditions**

5. The replenished quantity of sand **8700 cum/annum** as per ARRS report is approved for the remaining lease period.
6. The EC is valid for the balance lease period subject to the quantity prescribed in the modified DSR or revised Mining Plan whichever is less.

7. The PP is required to carry out the Annual rate of replenishment study (ARRS) through ORSAC empanel agency in subsequent years and submit the report to SEIAA, Odisha.
8. The PP shall implement the EMP with a budgetary allocation as proposed in the EMP report during EC application.
9. The PP shall plant some tree species like Banyan, Peepal, Neem, Jamun, Mango, Karanj, Arjun etc. as part of tree plantation campaign "*Ek Ped Ma Ke Naam*" and the details of the same shall be uploaded in the MeriLiFE Portal (<https://merilife.nic.in>).
10. The Project Proponent shall uploaded/submitted six monthly EC compliance in the Parivesh Portal of MoEF & CC., Govt. of India only falling which the EC is liable to revoked.



**1. Proposal in brief:**

The highlights of the proposal as ascertained from the application and as revealed from proceedings/discussion held during the meeting of SEAC/SEIAA, are given as under.

- (i) This is a proposal for amendment of EC of Telijore Sand Bed over an area of 8.30 Acres or 3.358 ha at village-Telijore, Tahasil- Balisankara, District-Sundargarh, Odisha.
- (ii) The project proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, Odisha vide EC letter no. /EC Identification No. – 1177/SEIAA dt. 30.03.2021 for Telijore Sand Bed over an area of 8.30 Acres or 3.358 ha at village-Telijore, Tahasil- Balisankara, District-Sundargarh, Odisha.
- (iii) During EC application the PP has submitted required documents along with mining plan where it is mentioned that mineable reserve of the proposed sand bed is 27822 cum with depth of sand deposition was 1.0 meter and proposed for annual extraction-5000 cum.
- (iv) The SEIAA allowed 5000 cum of sand for 1<sup>st</sup> year production with depth of mining 1.0 meter.
- (v) There is an EC conditions point no. 9.1 to 9.2 in page no. 03 that “Pending carrying out of the study & submission of the report, this clearance is being granted in an adhoc manner and is liable to be revoked after one year i.e., after 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2022, if satisfactory replenishment study report is not submitted.”
- (vi) Transfer of EC was issued vide letter no. EC24C0107OR5157739T dated 30.05.2024 in favour of Sri Ajay Kumar Patel, the successful bidder of the source.
- (vii) The PP has mentioned 5000 cum of sand has been extracted from the source in 1<sup>st</sup> year
- (viii) The PP has submitted replenishment study report was done by Areal Construction & Geo-India Services (ORSAC Empanelment Agencies) with mentioned that Pre-Monsoon standard elevation = 244.6883 m, post-monsoon standard elevation = 245.392 m and quantity of sand replenished = **14532 cum** and proposed production is 14532.05 cum.
- (ix) The DFO, Sundargarh has informed vide their letter no.6370 dated 14.11.2024 that the PP has deposited the amounting of Rs. 2.0 Lakh with District Environmental Society for raising tree plantation which has been credited in the A/c. No. 10969174121 of District Environment Society-Cum-DFO-Sundargarh.
- (x) Any deficiencies/omission have been noticed in the above documents-

2. **Whether SEAC recommended the proposal – Yes**, the proposal was placed in the SEAC meeting held on 31.08.2024 and **the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal** as per the Replenishment Study Report with **8719 cum** of sand subject to revision of mining plan where the maximum annual capacity is stated as 5000 cum.
