1. Deliberations of SEAC, Chhattisgarh : The project proponent has excavated 1,770 cubic in the year 2017-18 & 1,775 cubic in the year 2018-19. The project proponent has excavated more than the excavation quantity (1,500 cubic per year) mentioned in the issued environmental clearance, which falls in the category of violation. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change issued Standard Operating Procedure vide Office Memorandum dated 07.07.2021 regarding identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification 2006 in compliance to

order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in O.A. No.34/2020. In this Office Memorandum para 11 (B) (i) following is mentioned:- "As per extant regulations at the time of scoping, if it is viewed that the project activity is otherwise permissible, Terms of Reference (TOR) shall be issued with directions to complete the impact assessment studies & submit Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report & Environmental Management Plan (EMP) in a time bound manner." As per the above OM and the applied case is a violation, project proponent needs to apply in TOR, but project proponent applied directly for Environment Clearance. After discussion by the Committee, as per the above facts, it was unanimously decided to reject the applied case from the list and recommended to apply for TOR as per the Notification/Office Memorandum issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change from time to time.

2. Deliberations of SEIAA, Chhattisgarh - SEIAA in its 187th Meeting held on 12/03/2025 perused the application submitted by the project proponent and minutes of the 558th meeting of SEAC-3, Chhattisgarh held on 30/01/2025. It is noted that the project proponent has excavated 1,770 cubic meter in the year 2017-18 & 1,775 cubic meter in the year 2018-19. The project proponent has excavated more than the permissible quantity (1,500 cubic meter per year) mentioned in the environmental clearance, which falls in the category of violation. Standard Operating Procedure was issued by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide Office Memorandum dated 07.07.2021 regarding the identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification 2006 in compliance to order of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in O.A. No.34/2020. In this Office Memorandum para 11 (B) (i) following is mentioned:- "As per extant regulations at the time of scoping, if it is viewed that the project activity is otherwise permissible, Terms of Reference (TOR) shall be issued with directions to complete the impact assessment studies & submit Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report & Environmental Management Plan (EMP) in a time bound manner." As per the above OM, the applied case is a violation case, hence the project proponent needs to apply for TOR, but project proponent has applied directly for Environment Clearance. **SEIAA, Chhattisgarh unanimously accepted the recommendation of SEAC-3, Chhattisgarh and decided to delist/reject the applied case.**
