Sub: Proposal for Amendment of Environmental Clearance (EC) of Dumurigoda River Sand Quarry over an area 5.00acres or 2.023ha in Dumurigoda village under Patna Tahasil of Keonjhar District Odisha of Sri Bharata Chandra Sahu, the PP/Successful bidder/lessee-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to your online application no. SIA/OR/MIN/460017/2024 dated 27.01.2024, wherein you have requested for amendment (i.e. amendment of EC regard to annual production of sand as per replenishment study report) of Environmental Clearance (EC) granted by SEIAA, Odisha vide letter no./EC Identification No. EC22B001OR146568 dated 07.05.2022 in favour of Sri Bharata Chandra Sahu, the lessee/successful bidder.

2. The application was examined in the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha in its 162nd meeting held on 03.04.2024 & 04.04.2024 in accordance with the EIA Notification, 2006 as amended from time to time and the following points are noted;

- (i) This is a proposal for amendment of EC of Dumurigoda Sand Quarry over an area 5.00acres or 2.023ha in Dumurigoda village under Patna tahasil of Keonjhar district Odisha.
- (ii) The project proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, Odisha vide EC letter no. EC Identification No.– EC22B001OR146568 dated 07.05.2022 & EC transferred on 29.11.2022 for Dumurigoda Sand Quarry over an area 5.00acres or 2.023ha in Dumurigoda village under Patna Tahasil of Keonjhar district Odisha.
- (iii) During EC application the PP has submitted required documents along with mining plan where it is mentioned that mineable reserve of the proposed sand was 15510 cum with depth of sand deposition was 1.0 meter and proposed for annual extraction-3102 cum.
- (iv) The SEIAA allowed 2000 cum of sand for the 1st year with depth of mining 1.5 meter.
- (v) There is an EC conditions point no. 7.1 to 7.2 in page no. 03 that “Pending carrying out of the study & submission of the report, this clearance is being granted in an adhoc manner and is liable to be revoked after one year i.e. after November 2022, if satisfactory replenishment study report is not submitted.”

- (vi) The PP has mentioned that 20001 cum of sand has been extracted from the source 1st year.
 - (vii) The PP has submitted of Rs. 1,35,000/- to District Environmental Society, Keonjhar towards raising tree plantation
 - (viii) The ARRS study done by Sri Manas Ranjan Mohanta, RQP and (ORSAC Empanelment Agencies) with mentioned that Mineable Reserve during Pre-monsoon survey- 2023 = 3046Cum, Mineable Reserve during Post-monsoon survey-2023 = 3480Cum and quantity of sand replenished is 434 cum and proposed production is 3480 cum.
 - (ix) Documents submitted for amendment of EC;
 - a. Form No. 4 for amendment of Environmental Clearance,
 - b. Replenishment study report
3. The proposal was placed in SEAC meeting held on 26.02 2024 and The SEAC decided to recommend the proposal as per the replenishment study report submitted. The replenished volume of sand is 434 cum which is recommended for extraction for next year subjected to modification of Mining Plan.
4. Amendment of Environmental Clearance (EC) letter no./Identification no. EC22B001OR146568 dated 07.05.2022 issued for Dumurigoda River Sand Quarry in favour of Sri Bharata Chandra Sahu is **allowed** for extraction quantity of sand **434 cum per year** for the rest of the lease period i.e. for the 2nd year, 3rd year, 4th year and 5th year. The other stipulated terms and conditions of the original EC initially granted remains same subject to satisfactory compliance to all the stipulated terms and conditions of EC along with following additional stipulation:

Additional stipulation

- (i) The PP is required to carry out the Annual rate of replenishment study (ARRS) through ORSAC empanel agency in subsequent year and submit the report to SEIAA, Odisha.
- (ii) The validity of EC is for validity of DSR or validity of lease period whichever is earlier.
- (iii) The PP will implement the EMP with a budgetary allocation as proposed in the EMP report during EC application.

The Project Proponent shall uploaded/submitted six monthly EC compliance in the Parivesh Portal of MoEF & CC., Govt. of India only within six months (06) from date of issue of transfer of EC, falling which the EC is liable to revoked.

In case, there is a change in the scope of the project, fresh Environment Clearance shall be obtained.


