Sub: SEIAA, A.P. – 11.370 Ha Mining of Laterite of Sri B. Rajendra Prasad, at Sy.No: 01(P) Dokkuluru Village, G.K.Veedhi Mandal, AlluriSeetharamaraju District (Erstwhile Visakhapatnam District), Andhra Pradesh – Standard TOR - issued –Reg.

Ref: 1. Your application dt: 04/12/2024 received through online vide Proposal No. **SIA/AP/MIN/511258/2024**.
2. SEAC meeting held on **13.12.2024**.
3. SEIAA meeting held on **18.01.2025**.

With reference to the above, it is to inform that your application was examined by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), A.P in its **249th meeting** held on **13.12.2024** and committee noted that:

Category: B2 at par with B1.

1. The proposed project is for mining of **Laterite** in an area of **11.370 Ha.** with a proposed production quantity of **Laterite - 367540 TPA** with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/ plan.
2. The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (≤ 250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).
3. The project proponent and their consultant, M/s. **SV ENVIRO LABS & CONSULTANTS** have attended the meeting and presented their proposal. The SEAC Committee noted that:
 - a. The Department of Mines and Geology submitted DSR of **Seetharamaraju** District. The same is reviewed in the SEAC meeting

and observed that the mineral content is available at Page-No. 79 of DSR.

- b. The Department of Mines and Geology vide order dt 25.10.2024 issued Extension of Lol to the subject mine for a period of 20 years and the same is valid upto 24.10.2025.
 - c. The Committee noted that as per the cluster letter dated: 21.11.2024 issued by the Mines & Geology Department, there are no existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mtrs area. **The total cluster area is > 5.0 Ha.**
 - d. As per the approved mining plan dt. 12.02.2018, the total available mineral reserves are **20,85,257T**. The proponent proposed to excavate **Laterite – 3,67,540 TPA**. The Life of the mine is 6.0 years.
 - e. The committee noted that the proposed mine lease is on slope of the hill, hence committee directed the project proponent to submit surface runoff prevention measures plan and shall estimate construction cost for trench to prevent surface runoff.
 - f. The committee noted the proposed mine lease area is covered with thick green belt hence, committee directed the project proponent to submit tree enumeration plan.
 - g. The committee noted that the habitation is existing at distance about 78m from mine lease area. Hence, committee directed the project proponent to submit modified mining plan at the time of applying of EC.
4. The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to **issue Standard Terms Reference** for mining of Laterite - 367540 TPA **with Public Hearing** over a period of 6 years, covering an area of 11.370 hectares, in favour of Sri B. Rajendra Prasad, at Sy.No: 01(P) Dokkuluru Village, G. K. Veedhi Mandal, AlluriSeetharamaraju District. The recommendation is subject to the following additional conditions:
- i. The project proponent shall prepare EIA& EMP
 - ii. The project proponent shall prepare a detailed plantation plan including no. of species and type of species and area of land allocated for greenbelt.
 - iii. The project proponent shall submit surface runoff prevention measures plan along with budget estimates and allocation for construction of trench along the slope sides of the boundary of the lease area to prevent surface runoff.
 - iv. The project proponent shall submit approach road plan.

- v. The project proponent shall submit tree enumeration.
 - vi. The project proponent shall submit modified mining plan in accordance with NGT norms.
5. The issue was placed before the SEIAA, A.P., in its 249th SEIAA meeting held on 18.01.2025 and SEIAA **Agreed** with the recommendations of SEAC to issue **Standard Terms of Reference with Public hearing with an additional condition** that the project proponent shall enumerate trees, shrubs & herbs and identify if there are any endangered species and any loss of species diversity due to proposed mining.

In view of the above, you are requested to prepare EIA report accordingly based on the **Standard Terms of Reference with Public Hearing** with the above additional TORs and submit to the SEAC, A.P., accordingly for appraisal. The Terms of the reference are valid for a period of Four years.
