In view of the particulars given in the Para 1 above, the project proposal interalia including Form, Reports were submitted to the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) under the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments.

The above-mentioned proposal has been considered by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) of in the meeting held on 30/05/2024.The minutes of the meeting and all the Application and documents submitted (viz. CAF and Form-6)

are available on PARIVESH portal which can be accessed by scanning the QR Code above.

The brief about configuration of plant/equipment, products and by products and salient features of the project along with environment settings, as submitted by the Project proponent in Form-6 presented during are annexed to this EC as Annexure (1) and Annexure (2).

The SEAC, in its meeting held on 30/05/2024, based on information & clarifications provided by the project proponent and after detailed deliberations recommended the proposal for Rejection of Environment Clearance under the provision of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof subject to stipulation of specific and general conditions as detailed in the point below.

The SEAC has examined the proposal in accordance with the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 & further amendments thereto and after accepting the recommendations of the SEIAA hereby decided to Reject Environment Clearance for instant proposal of Shri Rajib Sarmah under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof.

“The SEAC Committee also deemed it expedient to call for a report from the PCBA if at all CTE for establishing a Hospital by the Proponent, as applicant or his Company, has applied for as it may require EC for the purpose which require further examination. In the event the EC required the action taken by the Proponent so far shall be violation of the provisions prescribed under the EIA Notification Dated 14.09.2006.

1. The SEAC Committee is considering the instant matter to be a case of violation and the penalty shall need to be levied after receipt of the detailed report from the concerned DFO.

2. The SEAC Committee desire to have a ground report as to the issue of CTE by the PCBA in respect of the plot of land wherein a Hospital is proposed to be constructed to examine if the provisions of the EIA, 2006 are not violated.

3. In view of the report of the sub-Committee of SEAC, Assam the grant of the EC by the SEIAA is not recommended.”

Therefore, SEIAA Authority is rejected the EC with the subject to condition laid down by the SEAC.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
