

Sub SEIAA, A.P.– 4.965 Ha, Colour Granite Mine of M/s Shree Mahadeshwara : Granites at Sy.No.532 (Old Sy.No.26/3P) of Rajanam Village, Kuppam Mandal, Chittoor District, Andhra Pradesh – Standard TOR - issued –Reg.

Ref: 1. Your application dt.26.04.2024 received through online vide Proposal No. **SIA/AP/MIN/470668/2024.**
2. SEAC meeting held on 15.11.2024.
3. SEIAA meeting held on 29.11.2024.

With reference to the above, it is to inform that your application was examined by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), A.P in its **245th meeting** held on 14.11.2024 and Minutes of the meeting are as follows:

Category: B2 at par with B1.

The proposed project is for mining of Colour Granite in an area of 4.965 Ha. with a proposed production quantity of 9,610 m³/annum with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per approved Mining plan/ scheme

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (\leq 250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The project proponent and their consultant, M/s. **Ecomen Mining Pvt Ltd** have attended the meeting and presented their proposal. The SEAC Committee noted that:

- a. The Department of Mines and Geology submitted DSR of Chittoor District and observed that the mineral content is available in Rajanam Village at page no 62 of DSR.
- b. The Department of Mines and Geology vide order dt 14.03.2024 issued LoI to the subject mine for a period of 20 years subject to submission of Approved Mining Plan, EC and CFE within a period of 3 years from the date of issue of LoI.
- c. The Committee noted that as per the cluster letter dated: 04.04.2024 issued by the Mines & Geology Department, there are 04 existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mtrs area. The total cluster area is 15.315 Ha. Which is > 5.0 Ha.
- d. As per the approved mining plan dt. 04.04.2024, the total available mineral reserves are 2,21,100 m³. The proponent proposed to excavate – **9,610 m³/annum**. The Life of the mine is 23 years.
- e. The committee noted that a water pond exists approximately 120 meters from the proposed mine. Therefore, the committee directs the project proponent to submit a plan for surface runoff prevention and to estimate the construction cost for a trench to mitigate surface runoff.
- f. The committee noted that there is an existing canal passing approximately 300 meters on the southern side. Therefore, the committee directs the project proponent to assess the impact of mining activities on the canal. Additionally, the proponent is instructed to submit a transportation plan that avoids the canal road.
- g. The committee noted that the project proponent has allocated 0.756 hectares of land within the mine lease area for waste disposal, as outlined in the approved mining plan.
1. The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended **to issue Standard Terms Reference with Public Hearing** for the mining of Colour Granite (9,610 m³ per annum) over a period of 23 years, covering an area of **4.965 hectares, in favor of M/s Shree Mahadeshwara Granites, located at Survey No. 532 (Old Sy. No. 26/3P) of Rajanam Village, Kuppam Mandal, Chittoor District**. The recommendation is subject to the following additional conditions:
 - i. The project proponent shall prepare cluster EIA& EMP
 - ii. The project proponent shall prepare a detailed plantation plan including no. of species and type of species and area of land allocated for greenbelt.
 - iii. The project proponent shall submit approach road plan.
 - iv. The project proponent shall assess the impact of mining activities on the canal.
 - v. The proponent shall submit a transportation plan that avoids the canal road.
 - vi. The proponent shall submit a plan for surface runoff prevention and to estimate the construction cost for a trench to mitigate surface runoff.

2. The issue was placed before the SEIAA, A.P., in its 245th meeting held on 29.11.2024 and **SEIAA Agreed with the recommendations of SEAC to issue Standard Terms Reference with Public Hearing.**

In view of the above, you are requested to prepare EIA report accordingly based on the Standard TOR with Public hearing with the above additional TORs/ Conditions and submit to the SEAC, A.P., for appraisal. The Terms of the reference are valid for a period of Four years.
