



With reference to the above, it is to inform that your application was examined by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), A.P in its **269th meeting** held on 29.07.2025 and committee noted the following:

- a. The committee noted that the mining unit carried out mining operation without valid Environmental Clearance. Hence, the project falls under violation category.
- b. The committee noted that the MoEF&CC, GoI issued an OM dated 08.01.2024, informing that the Hon'ble Supreme Court had imposed a stay on the implementation of the SOP dated 07.07.2021 and the OM dated 28.01.2022.
- c. This proposal was placed in 252nd SEAC meeting and the committee observed that stay has been imposed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on the implementation of the SOP dated 7th July 2021 and the OM dated 28th January 2022. Hence the committee decided to consider violation proposals only after the final outcome of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition(s) Civil No(s). 1394/2023 and further orders received from MoEF&CC, GoI. Therefore, the committee recommended to **raise an ADS**.

- d. Again, this proposal was placed in 269th meeting and noted that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India, issued an Office Memorandum dated 26.05.2025. The Memorandum states that the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide judgment dt. 16.05.2025 in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No. 1394/2023, has quashed the Notification S.O. 804(E) dated 14.03.2017, along with the Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) dated 07.07.2021.

In light of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide judgment dt. 16.05.2025 in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No. 1394/2023 and Office Memorandum dated 26.05.2025 wherein Notification S.O. 804(E) dated 14.03.2017 and the Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) dated 07.07.2021 were struck down, the Committee recommended that **SEIAA to reject the concerned proposals.**

- I. The issue was placed before the SEIAA, A.P., in its 269^h SEIAA meeting held on 14.08.2025 and SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of SEAC to reject the concerned proposal.
- II. In view of the above, your **application for Violation TOR is here by REJECTED**. No mining / construction / expansion or developmental work shall be carried out without obtaining Environmental Clearance as per the provisions laid under E(P) Act, 1986 and EIA notification 2006 dt.14.09.2006 and its amendments thereof. Any appeal against this order shall lie with the National Green Tribunal, if preferred, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 16 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.
