Sir/Madam,

This has reference to your online application no. SIA/OR/MIN/460014/2024 dated 27.01.2024, wherein you have requested for amendment (i.e. amendment of EC regard to annual production of sand as per replenishment study report) of Environmental Clearance (EC) granted by SEIAA, Odisha vide letter no./EC Identification No. EC22B001OR129994 dated 24.11.2022 in favour Sri Mukesh Kumar Agrwal, the successful bidder/lessee.

2. The application was examined in the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha in its 166th meeting held on 07.05.2024 & 08.05.2024 in accordance with the EIA Notification, 2006 as amended from time to time and the following points are noted;

- (i) This is a proposal for amendment of EC of Gilli Sand Bed over an area 12.22Ac or 4.94Hac in Gilli village under Bonai Tahasil of Sundargarh district Odisha.
- (ii) The project proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, Odisha vide EC letter no. EC Identification No.– EC22B001OR129994 dated 24.11.2022 for Gilli Sand Bed over an area 12.22Ac or 4.94Hac in Gilli village under Bonai Tahasil of Sundargarh District Odisha.
- (iii) During EC application the PP has submitted approved mining plan with mentioned that the mineable reserve is 63485 cum with depth of sand deposition 1.5 meter and proposed production per annum was 40000 cum.
- (iv) The SEIAA allowed 40000 cum of sand for 1st year production and 10000 cum for 2nd year (i.e. 25% of the 1st year production quantity approved in EC letter if ARRS is not submitted after one year)
- (v) There is an EC conditions point no. 7.1 to 7.2 of part-B in page no. 05 that the PP is required complied the conditions before lease agreement.
- (vi) The PP has submitted clarification with mentioned that 25701 cum of sand has been extracted from the source against 40000 cum sand approved in the EC letter. The PP also submitted the acknowledgement



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- receipt that Rs. 2,25,000/- has been deposited to District Environmental Society for raising plantation.
- (vii) The ARRS study done by Zinu Sh. Sathua with mentioned that Pre-Monsoon mineable reserve-33211 cum, post-monsoon reserve = 44234 cum and quantity of sand replenished 11023 cum and proposed production for next year is 40000 cum.
- (viii) Documents submitted for amendment of EC;
- Form No. 4 for amendment of Environmental Clearance,
 - Replenishment study report
3. The proposal was placed in SEAC meeting held on 26.02.2024 and the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal as per the replenishment study report submitted. The replenished volume of sand is 11023 cum which is recommended for extraction for next year subjected to modification of Mining Plan.
4. Amendment of Environmental Clearance (EC) letter no./Identification no. EC22B001OR129994 dated 24.11.2022 issued for Gilli River Sand Quarry in favour of Sri Mukesh Kumar Agrwal is **allowed** for extraction quantity of sand **11023 cum per annum** for the balance lease period. The other stipulated terms and conditions of the original EC initially granted remains same subject to satisfactory compliance to all the stipulated terms and conditions of EC along with following additional stipulation:

Additional stipulation

- The PP is required to carry out the Annual rate of replenishment study (ARRS) through ORSAC empanel agency in subsequent year and submit the report to SEIAA, Odisha.
- The validity of EC is for validity of DSR or validity of lease period whichever is earlier.
- The PP will implement the EMP with a budgetary allocation as proposed in the EMP report during EC application.

The Project Proponent shall uploaded/submitted six monthly EC compliance in the Parivesh Portal of MoEF & CC., Govt. of India only within six months (06) from date of issue of transfer of EC, falling which the EC is liable to revoked.

In case, there is a change in the scope of the project, fresh Environment Clearance shall be obtained.
