Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to your application submitted to SEIAA vide proposal number SIA/TN/MIN/489381/2024 dated 23/07/2024 for grant of an EXTENSION in prior Terms of Reference with Public hearing (ToR) issued to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

The Terms of Reference along with Public Hearing was accorded to Thiru. U. Prabhakaran for the Proposed Rough Stone & Gravel Quarry lease over an extent of 0.68.8 Ha at S.F. No. 389/1C2 of Morattupalayam Village, Uthukuli Taluk, Tiruppur District, Tamil Nadu with validity upto 22.08.2024. Now, the Project Proponent has applied for extension of validity of Terms of Reference.

SEAC Remarks:

The proposal was placed for appraisal in this 489th meeting of SEAC held on 08.09.2024. The details of the project

furnished by the proponent are given in the website (parivesh.nic.in).

The SEAC noted the following:

1. The Project Proponent, Thiru. U. Prabhakaran has applied for extension of validity of Terms of Reference for the Proposed Rough Stone & Gravel Quarry lease over an extent of 0.68.8 Ha at S.F. No. 389/1C2 of Morattupalayam Village, Uthukuli Taluk, Tiruppur District, Tamil Nadu.
2. The proposed quarry/activity is covered under Category “B1” of Item 1(a) “Mining Projects” of the Schedule to the EIA Notification, 2006, as amended.
3. Earlier, ToR along with Public Hearing was issued vide Lr No.SEIAA-TN/F.No.8614/SEAC/ToR-1019/2021 Dated:23.08.2021 with validity upto 22.08.2024.
4. As per MoEF&CC Office Memorandum dated: 08.06.2022, the validity of ToR shall be for a maximum period of four years in case of mining projects. Hence, the validity of the ToR issued is deemed to be valid upto **22.08.2025**.
5. The Project Proponent has given a representation dated 06.08.2024, stating that “*TNPCB had advertised for conducting Public Hearing on 03.09.2024 & requested to consider his ToR extension application.*”

Based on the presentation & documents furnished by the project proponent, the Committee decided to extend the validity period of ToR for a period of 1 year, i.e., up to **22.08.2025** subject to the following specific conditions.

1. The PP shall complete the fencing, tree plantation and photographs, videos of the same shall be furnished.
2. The PP shall complete the garland drainage around the boundary of the proposed quarry and the photographs indicating the same shall be shown during the EIA appraisal.
3. The PP shall carry out drone video survey covering the cluster, green belt, fencing, etc.
4. **All other conditions mentioned in the ToR vide Lr No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.8614/SEAC/ToR-1019/2021 Dated:23.08.2021 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.**

SEIAA Remarks:

The subject was placed in the 750th authority meeting held on 29.08.2024. The Authority noted that the subject was appraised in the 489th SEAC meeting held on 08.08.2024. Based on the presentation & documents furnished by the project proponent, the Committee decided to extend the validity period of ToR for a period of 1 year i.e., up to **22.08.2025** subject to the conditions stated therein.

After detailed discussions, the Authority taking into account the recommendations of SEAC, decided to grant extension of validity of Terms of Reference (ToR) for a period of 1 year, i.e., up to **22.08.2025** subject to the specific conditions stipulated by SEAC. All other conditions stipulated in the ToR vide Lr No.SEIAA-TN/F.No.8614/SEAC/ToR-1019/2021 Dated:23.08.2021 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.
