

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to your online application no. SIA/OR/MIN/462272/2024 dated 09.02.2024, wherein you have requested for amendment (i.e. amendment of EC regard to annual production of sand as per replenishment study report) of Environmental Clearance (EC) granted by SEIAA, Odisha vide letter no./EC Identification No. EC22B001OR162554 dt. 31.03.2022 in favour of Sri Sarat Chandra Naik, the lessee/successful bidder.

2. The application was examined in the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Odisha in its 162nd meeting held on 03.04.2025 & 04.04.2024 in accordance with the EIA Notification, 2006 as amended from time to time and the following points are noted;

- (i) This is a proposal for amendment of EC of Sidhua River Jaripada Sand Quarry over an area 25.00 acres or 10.11 Ha village Jaripada under Cuttack Sadar Tahasil Cuttack District Odisha.
- (ii) The project proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, Odisha vide EC letter no. – EC22B001OR189302 dt. 03.06.2022 for Sidhua River Jaripada Sand Quarry over an area 25.00 acres or 10.11 Ha village Jaripada under Cuttack Sadar Tahasil Cuttack District Odisha.
- (iii) During EC application the PP has submitted required documents along with mining plan where it is mentioned that mineable reserve of the proposed sand was 168018 cum with depth of sand deposition was 2.0 meter and proposed for annual extraction-140220 cum.
- (iv) The SEIAA allowed 20000 cum of sand for 1st year production with depth of mining 1.0 meter.
- (v) There is an EC conditions point no. 7.1 to 7.2 in page no. 04 that “Pending carrying out of the study & submission of the report, this clearance is being granted in an adhoc manner and is liable to be revoked after one year i.e. after November 2022, if satisfactory replenishment study report is not submitted.”



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- (vi) The PP has mentioned that 18880 cum sand has been extracted from the source for the period 2022-23.
- (vii) Amendment of EC proposal was placed in SEIAA meeting held on 30.12.2023 and after detailed deliberation the Authority rejected the proposal as per SEIAA recommendation. Now, the PP has requested for reconsider of the proposal.
- (viii) The replenishment study was done by the RQP, Sri Bipin Bihari Khandual with mentioned that the Pre-Monsoon RL is 21.32 and Post-Monsoon RL is 21.63 and quantity of sand replenished is 25916 cum and proposed production is 15000 cum/annum.
- (ix) Documents submitted for amendment of EC;
- Form No. 4 for amendment of Environmental Clearance,
 - Replenishment study report
3. The proposal was placed in SEAC meeting held on 27.02.2024 and the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal as per the replenishment study report submitted. The replenished volume of sand is 25916 cum which is recommended for extraction for next year subjected to approval of revised approved mining plan as per the sustainable sand mining guidelines.
- However, EC shall be granted only after ensuring the following.
- (i) Certification from appropriate authorities such as Deputy Director, Geology or Tahasildar etc. stating that no river bed sand mining operation was done during the year FY 2023 – 2024 as the PP has submitted riverbed sand replenishment study was carried out during FY-2022 – 2023 instead of FY-2023 – 2024.
4. The proposal was placed in the 161st meeting of SEIAA and after detailed deliberation in the matter, the authority decided to seek clarification on the following:
- (i) Certification from appropriate authorities such as Deputy Director, Geology or Tahasildar etc. stating that no river bed sand mining operation was done during the year FY2023 – 2024 as the riverbed sand replenishment study was carried out during FY2022 – 2023 instead of FY2023 – 2024. Accordingly, ADS raised by SEIAA, Odisha on 04.04.2024 and the PP has submitted reply of ADS letter on 04.04.2024.
4. Amendment of Environmental Clearance (EC) letter no./Identification no. EC22B001OR189302 dt. 03.06.2022 issued for Sidhua River Jaripada Sand Quarry in favour of Sri Pranakrushna Nayak is **allowed** for extraction quantity of sand i.e. **25916 cum/annum** for the rest of the lease period i.e. for the 2nd year, 3rd year, 4th year and 5th year. The other stipulated terms and conditions of the original EC initially granted remains same subject to satisfactory compliance to all the stipulated terms and conditions of EC along with following additional stipulation:



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Additional stipulation

- (i) The PP is required to carry out the Annual rate of replenishment study (ARRS) through ORSAC empanel agency in subsequent year and submit the report to SEIAA, Odisha.
- (ii) The validity of EC is for validity of DSR or validity of lease period whichever is earlier.
- (iii) The Project Proponent (lease holder) shall deposit Rs.5,00,000/- with the respective District Environment Society for raising 1000 plants (minimum @100 trees per Ha) of native species within 2 years in a suitable location adjoining to quarry.
- (iv) The PP shall implement the EMP cost is mentioned in the EMP report and submitted it during EC application.

The Project Proponent shall uploaded/submitted six monthly EC compliance in the Parivesh Portal of MoEF & CC., Govt. of India only within six months (06) from date of issue of transfer of EC, falling which the EC is liable to revoked.

In case, there is a change in the scope of the project, fresh Environment Clearance shall be obtained.
