Rakesh Nagdeo. But all the documents related to the mine are in the name of Mr. Gopal Prasad Agrawal, hence the committee has directed to make a revised online application in the name of Mr. Gopal Prasad Agrawal.

Based on that SEAC recommended to reject the application. SEIAA, Chhattisgarh unanimously accepted the recommendation of SEAC-2, and decided to reject the applied case.
