Subject: Amendment in Environmental Clearance (EC) 17/07/2024 granted to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006 as amended -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to your application submitted to SEIAA vide proposal number SIA/TN/MIN/477893/2024 dated 17/07/2024 for grant of an amendment in prior Environmental Clearance (EC) to the project Proposed Ordinary Earth quarry lease over an extent of 3.14.40Ha at SF.No. 86/2 (P) (PWD Tank) of Kilambi Village, Kancheepuram Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamil Nadu by Thiru. V. Raguvaran under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

2. The particulars of the proposal are as below :

1. In view of the particulars given in the Para 1 above, the project proposal interalia including Form-4(Part A, B and C)/

Reports were submitted to the SEIAA for an appraisal by the SEAC under the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments.

2. Remarks of SEAC :

Proposed Savudu Deposit quarry lease over an extent of 3.14.40Ha at SF.No. 86/2 (P) (PWD Tank) of Kilambi Village, Kancheepuram Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamil Nadu by Thiru. V. Raghuvaran - For Amendment in Environmental Clearance.

(SIA/TN/MIN/477893/2024, Dated:31.05.2024)

The proposal was placed in the 483rd meeting of SEAC held on 18.07.2024. The details of the project furnished by the proponent are available in the website (parivesh.nic.in).

The SEAC noted the following:

1. The Environmental Clearance was earlier issued to the project proponent, Thiru. V.Raghuvaran for the Proposed Savudu Deposit quarry lease over an extent of 3.14.40Ha at SF.No. 86/2 (P) (PWD Tank) of Kilambi Village, Kancheepuram Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamil Nadu vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.4094/1(a)/EC. No. 2264/2015 dated 23.10.2015 for the quantity of 28,296m³ of savudu for the period of 50days from the date of execution of mining lease period.

2. Earlier EC - Amendment Issued Vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.4094/EC/1(a)/A/2264/2015 dated:12.03.2018.

3. The project proponent has informed that the mining lease deed has not been executed so far due to following reasons,

4. "...Among other reasons such as rainy seasons, Hon'ble High Court order (Prohibiting the colloquial name of Savudu) and Covid Pandemic, The Government of Tamil Nadu vide G.O (Ms) 50.dated 27.04.2017 has banned quarrying of Clay, Silt, Savudu and Gravel on the beds of tanks, channels and reservoirs in the districts of Tiruvallur, Kanchipuram and Chennai. And now The Government of Tamil Nadu vide G.O. Ms. No. 244, Industries, Investment Promotion and Commerce (MMC.1) 14th December 2022 has lifted that ban."

5. Now, the Proponent, Thiru. V. Raghuvaran, has submitted an application in Form-4 seeking amendment in Environmental Clearance dated. 23.10.2015, requesting to change the mineral name to 'ordinary earth' instead of 'savudu'.

6. However, the proponent submitted a letter obtained from Deputy Director – Geology & Mining, vide Rc.218/Q3/2015 dated.08.05.2024 stating as follows:

"... in the approved mining plan dated.18.09.2015 it may please be read as "ordinary earth" in all the places where it was mentioned as "savudu"..."

7. Further, the proponent submitted the soil test report obtained from University of Madras, department of Geology. Guindy campus vide Ref.No:29/Dr.PS/ Raghuvaran/Kilambi/ Soil Test/ 2024 dated.24.04.2024. According to the report, the maximum sand content in the soil sample is determined as 56%. The Soil is classified as "ordinary earth".

8. Further, the proponent submitted a letter dated.08.05.2024 obtained from Deputy Director– Geology & Mining stating that the applied area/ proposed quarry site does not lie adjoining to river, canals, streams, etc., and also not comes under notified, declared protected zones.

9. Now, the PP has requested Amendment in EC as follows:

Based on the presentation and details submitted by the project proponent, the Committee decided to recommend the Amendment in the EC dated 23.10.2015 as follows:

1) The word "savudu" in all the places where it was mentioned in the EC issued by SEIAA-TN vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.4094/1(a)/EC. No. 2264/2015 dated 23.10.2015, may be read as "ordinary earth"

2) All other conditions and validity mentioned in the EC dated. 23.10.2015 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.

3. Discussion of SEIAA:

The subject was placed in the 744th authority meeting held on 05.08.2024. The authority noted that the subject was appraised in the 483th meeting of SEAC held on 18.07.2024. Based on the presentation and details submitted by the project proponent, the Committee decided to recommend the Amendment in the EC dated 23.10.2015 as follows:

1. The word "savudu" wherever occurred in the EC issued by SEIAA-TN Vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.4094/1(a)/EC. No. 2264/2015 dated 23.10.2015 may be read as an "ordinary earth"

2. All other conditions and validity mentioned in the EC dated. 23.10.2015 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.

The Authority after detailed discussions, accepts the recommendation of SEAC and decided to grant Amendment in the Environmental Clearance in the EC issued vide Vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.4094/1(a)/EC. No. 2264/2015 dated

23.10.2015 as follows. This is also subject to the conditions imposed by SEAC, in addition to the following conditions.

- 1) The word “*savudu*” wherever occurred in the EC issued by SEIAA-TN Vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.4094/1(a)/EC. No. 2264/2015 dated 23.10.2015., may be read as an “*ordinary earth*”
- 2) The removal of ordinary earth should not disturb the agriculture/horticulture activities, Biodiversity & drainage pattern.
- 3) The proposed activity should in no way cause any impact on the livelihoods and road situated adjacent to the tank.
- 4) No mining/Production activity should be outside the mine lease area.
- 5) All other conditions and validity mentioned in the EC dated. 23.10.2015 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.
