This is in reference to your application submitted to SEIAA, Punjab vide proposal number SIA/PB/THE/580954/2026 dated 08/06/2026 for grant of an amendment in prior Environmental Clearance (EC) to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

3) This is in reference to your online application submitted through PARIVESH Portal on 08.06.2026, for seeking amendment in Environmental Clearance granted vide letter no. DECC/SEIAA/2019/953 dated 02.12.2019 and transfer in Environmental Clearance granted for change in name from M/s Sukhbir Agro Energy Limited to M/s SAEL Limited by SEIAA, Punjab vide letter no. EC25B0608PB5243322T dated 13.04.2026, under the provisions of

EIA Notification 14.09.2006. The proposal of amendment has now been appraised as per the procedure prescribed under the provisions of EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006 based on mandatory documents enclosed with the application viz., Form-4, Environmental Clearance (EC) letters, a copy of compliance of the conditions of Environmental Clearance and additional clarifications furnished.

4) The proposal was considered by SEAC, Punjab in its 361st meeting held on 16.06.2026. After detailed deliberations, the Committee decided to accept the request of the industry to change the emission standard from 30 mg/Nm³ to 100mg/ Nm³ and decided to forward the case to SEIAA with the recommendations to grant Amendment in Environmental Clearance to M/s SAEL Limited located in the revenue estate of Village-Sedha Singh Wala, Tehsil Jaito, District Faridkot, Punjab in the subject to the suitable conditions and following special condition:

“The industry shall develop and maintain a minimum 15m green buffer zone all along the plant boundary. The greenbelt shall comprise multi-tier plantations of native broad-leaved evergreen tree species with high dust attenuation capacity, in accordance with prevalent guidelines issued by MoEF&CC/CPCB/PPCB etc. to effectively mitigate fugitive dust emissions and improve ambient air quality”

5) The proposal was considered by SEIAA in the 350th meeting held on 03.07.2026. After due deliberation, SEIAA decided to accept the recommendations of SEAC and to grant Amendment in Environmental Clearance to M/s SAEL Limited located in the revenue estate of Village-Sedha Singh Wala, Tehsil Jaito, District Faridkot, Punjab for change in the emission standard of Particulate Matter (PM) from 30 mg/Nm³ to 100mg/ Nm³, subject to the suitable conditions and special condition as imposed by the SEAC.

6) Accordingly, Environmental Clearance, is hereby amended as above subject to the same terms and conditions as imposed in the original Environmental Clearance granted vide letter no. DECC/SEIAA/2019/953 dated 02.12.2019 and transfer in Environmental Clearance granted for change in name from M/s Sukhbir Agro Energy Limited to M/s SAEL Limited by SEIAA, Punjab vide letter no. EC25B0608PB5243322T dated 13.04.2026 to M/s SAEL Limited.

7) This letter must remain appended with the original Environmental Clearance granted vide letter no. DECC/SEIAA/2019/953 dated 02.12.2019 and transfer in Environmental Clearance granted for change in name from M/s Sukhbir Agro Energy Limited to M/s SAEL Limited by SEIAA, Punjab vide letter no. EC25B0608PB5243322T dated 13.04.2026 to M/s SAEL Limited.

1. Special Condition

S. No	EC Conditions
