Subject: Extension in validity of prior Environmental Clearance (EC) dated granted to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006 and as amended thereof regarding Sand/Morrum mining along River Yamuna in Khand No.- O-4, Gata No-121 to 124 & 135 to 153 at Village-Oti, Tehsil-Fatehpur, District- Fatehpur, U. P.

Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to your application submitted to Ministry vide proposal number SIA/UP/MIN/498611/2024 dated 27/09/2024 for an extension in validity of prior Environmental Clearance (EC) granted to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

2. The particulars of the proposal are as below :

3. In view of the particulars given in the Para 1 above, the project proposal interalia including Form-6 were submitted to the SEAC under the provision of Para 9.0 of the EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments. Details in Form 6 can be accessed from the PARIVESH portal by scanning the QR Code above.
4. The brief about the reasons for an extension of validity of EC, as submitted by the Project Proponent in Form-6 and presented during SEIAA/SEAC is annexed to this letter as Annexure (1).
5. The above-mentioned proposal has been considered by SEAC meeting Dated 18-10-2024 and SEIAA in the meeting held on 26/11/2024. The minutes of the meeting and all the project documents are available on PARIVESH portal which can be accessed by scanning the QR Code above.
6. The SEIAA, in its meeting held on 26/11/2024 & SEAC, in its meeting held on 18-10-2024 based on information & clarifications provided by the project proponent and after detailed deliberations recommended the proposal for extension in validity in Environment Clearance under the provision of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof.
7. The SEIAA/SEAC has examined the proposal in accordance with the provisions contained in the Para 9 of Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 & further amendments thereto and based on the recommendations of the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) Appraisal Committee hereby accords Extension in Validity of Environment Clearance for the instant proposal of M/s. SANJAY KUMAR PANDEY under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof subject to compliance of EC conditions, general instructions issued vide EC letter dated 05-12-2019 .
8. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority

The consultant informed the committee that they are strictly following the rules, regulations and other instructions of QCI/NABET. A presentation was made by the project proponent along with their consultant M/s Paramarsh Servicing Environment and Development, Lucknow, U.P. Based on the documents submitted and presentation made by the project proponent along with the consultant, the following facts have emerged: -

- Earlier, environmental clearance for the above project proposal was issued by SEIAA, U.P. vide letter no. 445/Parya/SEAC/4558/2019, dated 05/12/2019 for an annual production of 5,34,450 cum in favour of Shri Upendra Kumar Gupta, S/o Shri Munnilal Gupta.
- Lease issued in favour of Shri Upendra Kumar Gupta, S/o Shri Munnilal Gupta, Fatehpur was cancelled by District Magistrate, Fatehpur vide its order no. 1871/30-Khanij (2020-21) dated 27/02/2021.
- Another LoI was issued in favour of M/s Shiv Ji Traders, Prop. Sanjay Kumar Pandey, S/o Shri Ganga Prasad Pandey, R/o- 584/430/1, Sector- M, L.D.A Colony Aashiyana, Lucknow for a period of 05 years with production capacity of 1,61,044 cum/annum vide letter no. 36/Khanij/Asay patra/Oti-O-4/2024 dated 04/01/2024.
- SEIAA, U.P. transfer the environmental clearance letter dated 05/12/2019 in favour of M/s Shiv Ji Traders prop. Sanjay Kumar Pandey S/o Shri Ganga Prasad Pandey R/o- 584/430/1, Sector- M, L.D.A Colony Aashiyana, Lucknow for production capacity of 1,61,044 cum/annum through EC Identification No. EC24B0107UP5727982T, dated 22/06/2024.
- Environmental clearance letter dated 05/12/2019 and transfer EC letter dated 22/06/2024 is valid upto 04/12/2024.
- The project proponent submitted an online EC extension application on Parivesh Portal vide proposal no. SIA/UP/MIN/498611/2024.
- During the presentation the project proponent informed the committee that MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide notification dated 18/01/2021 following provision has been made:

... "Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of Prior Environmental Clearances granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid."

In view of above provision the project proponent requested to relaxation granted for the period of 01 year (1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021) may be considered in validity of EC dated 05/12/2019 and extend the validity of environmental

clearance letter dated 05/12/2019 and transfer EC letter dated 22/06/2024 for the period of 01 year and after considering the relaxation provided by MoEF&CC vide notification dated 18/01/2021, the EC is valid upto 04/12/2025.

The SEIAA/SEAC discussed the matter in light of provision made in MoEF&CC Notification dated 18/01/2021 and documents submitted by the project proponent. The committee opined that as per provision in notification dated 18/01/2021 after considering the relaxation period of 01 year (1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021), the validity of environmental clearance letter dated 05/12/2019 which is already transferred in favour of M/s Shiv Ji Traders, Prop. Sanjay Kumar Pandey, S/o Shri Ganga Prasad Pandey may extended upto 04/12/2025 and after this period the original EC and transfer order both will become null and void.
