Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to your application submitted to SEIAA vide proposal number SIA/TN/MIN/467118/2024 dated 23/03/2024 for grant of Extension of validity of Terms of Reference with Public Hearing for the Proposed Rough Stone Quarry over an extent of 1.00.0 Ha at S.F.No.106 (Part) of Palapatti Village, Valappady Taluk, Salem District, Tamil Nadu by Thiru. S. Dhanapal under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

In the reference 2nd cited above, the Terms of Reference along with Public Hearing was accorded to Thiru. S.Dhanapal for the Proposed Rough Stone Quarry over an extent of 1.00.0 Ha at S.F.No.106 (Part) of Palapatti Village, Valappady Taluk, Salem District, Tamil Nadu with validity upto 15.04.2024 .

Now, the Project Proponent has applied for extension of validity of Terms of Reference vide reference 3rd & 4th cited.

3. In view of the particulars given in the Para 1 above, the project proposal interalia including Form-1(Part A and B) were submitted to the SEIAA for an appraisal by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in the Ministry under the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments.
4. The above-mentioned proposal has been considered by SEIAA in the meeting held on 29/07/2024 & 30/07/2024. The minutes of the meeting and all the project documents are available on PARIVESH portal which can be accessed by scanning the QR Code above.

5. **SEAC Remarks:**

1. The Project Proponent, Thiru. S.Dhanapal has applied for extension of validity of Terms of Reference for the Proposed Rough Stone Quarry over an extent of 1.00.0 Ha at S.F.No.106 (Part) of Palapatti Village, Valappady Taluk, Salem District, Tamil Nadu.
2. The proposed quarry/activity is covered under Category "B1" of Item 1(a) "Mining Projects" of the Schedule to the EIA Notification, 2006, as amended.
3. Earlier, ToR along with Public Hearing was issued vide Lr No.SEIAA-TN/F.No.8121/SEAC/ ToR-930/2020 Dated:16.04.2021 with validity upto 15.04.2024.
4. As per MoEF&CC Office Memorandum dated: 08.06.2022, the validity of ToR shall be for a maximum period of four years in case of mining projects. Hence, the validity of the ToR issued is deemed to be valid upto **15.04.2025**. Based on the presentation & documents furnished by the project proponent, the Committee decided to extend the validity period of ToR for a period of 1 year, i.e., up to **15.04.2025** subject to the following specific conditions.
 1. The PP shall complete the fencing, tree plantation and photographs, videos of the same shall be furnished.
 2. The PP shall complete the garland drainage around the boundary of the proposed quarry and the photographs indicating the same shall be shown during the EIA appraisal.
 3. The PP shall carry out drone video survey covering the cluster, green belt, fencing, etc.
 4. All other conditions mentioned in the ToR vide Lr No.SEIAA-TN/F.No.8121/SEAC/ ToR-930/2020 Dated:16.04.2021 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.

6. **SEIAA Remarks:**

The subject was placed in the **742nd Authority meeting held on 29.07.2024 & 30.07.2024**. The authority noted that the subject was appraised in the **481st meeting of SEAC held on 11.07.2024** and SEAC has furnished its recommendations to the Authority for granting **ToR Extension** to the project subject to the conditions stated therein.

After detailed discussion, the authority accepts the decision of SEAC. SEIAA directs the Project proponent ought to conduct the ToR Study within **15.04.2025** in addition to the following conditions:

No further extension in the ToR validity shall be entertained.
