This is in reference to your application submitted to Ministry vide proposal number SIA/OR/MIN/466474/2024 dated null for Rejection of prior Environmental Clearance (EC) to the project under the provision of the EIA Notification 2006-and as amended thereof.

1. In view of the particulars given in the Para 1 above, the project proposal interalia including Application for Amendment in EC- Form-4 were submitted to the SEAC, Odisha for an appraisal by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) under the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments.

2. The above-mentioned proposal has been considered in 175th Meeting of State Environment Impact Assessment Authority meeting held from 22/10/2024 to 23/10/2024 . Based on the recommendations of the State Expert Appraisal Committee, Odisha (SEAC, Odisha), information & clarifications provided by the project proponent and after detailed deliberations the Authority decided “After detailed deliberation in the matter, the authority accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to reject the amendment of EC application as the ARRS Report is not acceptable due to the following reasons:

i) In the ARRS report, the pre- monsoon and post monsoon survey, camera assessment errors are shown very high in units of meter (total camera location error is 94.73 m) and GCP locations error are in cm (total GCP error 2.87 cm) Such survey reports are erroneous and liable for giving erroneous results.

ii) There is no mention of average depth of replenishment of sand. The Lease area is on bend of river. Detail calculation of Safe workable area excluding concave portion has not been provided. Further, the authority decided to allow production quantity with the following conditions:-

1. The quantity previously approved is 18500 cum and the PP has already extracted 11600 cum. Hence, the balance extraction of 6900 cum is permissible for one year i.e. upto 31st December, 2025 with a precondition that the rectified ARRS report shall be submitted complying to the observations of SEAC.

2. Proof of deposit of Rs. 2.25 Lakhs with the District Environment Society for raising tree plantation. ”

Therefore, the proposal for Amendment in EC is Rejected as per provision of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof.
