1. In view of the particulars given in the Para above, the project proposal interalia including Form-1(C)/ EIA & EMP Reports were submitted to the Ministry for an appraisal by the State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority, Kerala under the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments.
2. The above-mentioned proposal has been considered by State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its 172nd meeting held during 8th & 9th October 2024 and the State Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) in its 150th meeting held on 27th and 28th November 2024. The minutes of the meeting and all the Application and documents submitted [(viz.

Form-1 Part A, Part B, Part C EIA, EMP)] are available on PARIVESH portal which can be accessed by scanning the QR Code above.

3. The SEAC in its 172nd meeting, examined the application and scrutinised the additional documents submitted by the project proponent dated 30/09/2024. As per the drone video of the site, it is an isolated hill that is virgin in nature. The Committee opined that such hills are reported to influence the micro climate and enhance the aesthetic environment of the area. Therefore, it is desirable to retain such an area without disturbing the natural landscape. Hence the committee recommended rejection of the proposal considering the importance of conservation of the environment of the proposed site and its locality.
4. The SEIAA, in its 150th meeting, has examined the proposal in accordance with the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 & further amendments thereto. On accepting the recommendations of the State Expert Appraisal Committee, the Authority decided to Reject the Environment Clearance for instant proposal of Sri. Abdul Basheer V. P. for the laterite building stone quarry project, under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof.
5. In the above circumstances, the application for Environmental Clearance submitted by **Sri. Abdul Basheer V.P, for the Laterite Building Stone Quarry project for an area of 0.9579 Ha, at Re-Survey Nos: 38/10, 46/10,46/12,38/12,46/14 in Atholi Village, Koylandi Taluk, Kozhikode District, Kerala is hereby REJECTED**, for the reasons mentioned above.
6. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
