Environmental Clearance was accorded vide Ec issued vide SEIAA-TN/F.No.6947/1(a)/EC.No.4167/2020 Dated:13.03.2020 to Thiru. K. Elangovan for the Proposed Ordinary Earth quarry lease over an extent of 3.16.00Ha at S.F.No. 708(P), WRD Tank, Madambakkam Village, Tambaram Taluk, Chengalpattu District (Erstwhile Kancheepuram District), Tamil Nadu.

Now, the Proponent has applied Amendment to Environmental Clearance vide Online proposal No. SIA/TN/MIN/501881/2024, Dated: 23.10.2024.

Remarks of SEAC:

Proposed Ordinary Earth quarry lease over an extent of 3.16.00Ha at S.F.No. 708(P), WRD Tank, Madambakkam Village, Tambaram Taluk, Chengalpattu District (Erstwhile Kancheepuram District), Tamil Nadu by Thiru. K. Elangovan – For Amendment to Environmental Clearance. (SIA/TN/MIN/501881/2024, Dated: 23.10.2024)

The proposal was placed for appraisal in this 508th meeting of SEAC held on 07.11.2024. The details of the project furnished by the proponent are available on the PARIVESH web portal (parivesh.nic.in). The project proponent made a detailed presentation.

The SEAC noted the following:

1. The Environmental Clearance was earlier issued to the project proponent, Thiru. K. Elangovan for the Savudu quarry lease over an extent of 3.16.00 Ha at S.F.No. 708(P), WRD Tank, Madambakkam Village, Tambaram Taluk, Chengalpattu District (Erstwhile Kancheepuram District), Tamil Nadu vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.6947/1(a)/EC.No.4167/2020 Dated:13.03.2020 for the quantity of 28314m³ of Savudu for the period of 70days from the date of execution of mining lease period.
2. The project proponent has informed that the mining lease deed has not been executed so far.
3. Now, the Proponent, Thiru. K. Elangovan, has submitted an application in Form-4 seeking amendment in Environmental Clearance dated. 13.03.2020, requesting to change the mineral name to ‘**ordinary earth**’ instead of ‘**savudu**’.
4. The PP has submitted a letter obtained from Deputy Director (Addl. Charge) – Geology & Mining, vide Rc.611/Q3/2018 dated.27.09.2024 stating as follows:
“... in the approved mining plan dated.26.06.2019 it may please be read as “ordinary earth” in all the places where it was mentioned as “savudu”...”
5. Further, the proponent submitted the soil test report obtained from Dept. of Geology & Mining, Guindy vide Certificate No. 24090122 dated.05.09.2024. According to the report, the maximum sand content in the soil sample is determined as 39.8%. The sample is named as “**ordinary earth**”.
6. Now, the PP has requested amendment to EC as follows:

Based on the presentation and details submitted by the project proponent, the Committee **decided to recommend the Amendment to the EC** dated 13.03.2020 as follows:

- 1) The word “**Savudu**” wherever occurred in the EC issued by SEIAA-TN vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No. 6947/1(a)/EC.No.4167/2020 Dated:13.03.2020, may be read as an “**Ordinary earth**”
- 2) All other conditions and validity mentioned in the EC dated. 13.03.2020 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.

Discussion of SEIAA:

The subject was placed in this **772nd meeting of SEIAA held on 19.11.2024**. The SEIAA noted that the subject was placed in the 508th meeting of SEAC held on 07.11.2024.

The SEAC held detailed discussions and decided to recommend for the grant of the requested amendment to the **EC issued vide Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.6947/1(a)/EC.No.4167/2020 Dated:13.03.2020**.

The Authority after detailed discussions, accepts the recommendation of SEAC and decided to issue the following amendment in the Environmental Clearance issued vide **Lr. No. SEIAA-TN/F.No.6947/1(a)/EC.No.4167/2020 Dated:13.03.2020** as follows. This is also subject to the conditions imposed by SEAC, in addition to the following conditions.

2. The removal of ordinary earth should not disturb the agriculture/horticulture activities, biodiversity & drainage pattern.
3. The proposed activity should in no way cause any impact on the livelihoods and road situated adjacent to the tank.
4. No mining/Production activity should be outside the mine lease area.

All other conditions mentioned in the EC dated. 13.03.2020 shall remain unchanged and unaltered.
