Remarks of SEIAA:

The subject was placed in the 925th SEIAA Meeting held on 01.12.2025.

The authority noted that the proposal was placed in the 643rd SEAC meeting held on 14.11.2025. Based on the presentation and details furnished by the project proponent, SEAC-II decided not to recommend the proposal for the following reasons:

1. The existing depth of mining is reported as 36m Above Ground Level (AGL) in the approved mining plan, whereas the approved depth is 20m as mentioned in the previous Environmental Clearance dated 01.04.2015. This discrepancy made the proposal to be considered as a violation category.
2. The applied mining lease area is relatively small (0.47.5 Ha). Further, it has been ascertained from the kml uploaded in the PARIVESH portal that the Project Proponent (PP) has not conducted quarrying operations in a proper manner and no proper benches are maintained as per the mining plan. Hence the scientific mining in this proposed site is not possible.

Hence, the Mining activity in this proposed area is not recommendable.

The Authority, after detailed deliberations, decided to accept the decision of SEAC-2 and **reject the proposal**. Hence, the file is closed and recorded.

Further, any appeal against this rejection shall lie with the National Green Tribunal, if preferred, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 16 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.
